## Holy Week

Holy Week is a special week for all of us and begins on Passion

(Palm Sunday) The remembering of the story of the Passion has touched hearts down through the centuries. Why are we so touched by recalling the events of the first Holy Week? Maybe because in the story of Jesus's Passion, we find our own life story. First, there's the Mass of Chrism on Holy Thursday morning, when priests renew their solemn promises. The Mass of the Lord's Supper that evening is like being at the Last Supper itself. The Mass begins in triumph, but ends in heartbreak, with the mournful procession to the Altar of Repose, from the Upper Room to Gethsemane.



Then **Good Friday** - a day for fasting and prayer. The Celebration of the Passion is so striking - the wood of the cross where our salvation was won.

**Holy Saturday** - a day of death, of waiting, Easter has not come yet. Then when all seems lost, the new light appears.

The **Easter Vigil** is the most important celebration of the year. Miss that, and you've missed it all. The forty days of Lent are to prepare for that Baptismal celebration. All the sadness and pain of Holy Week is replaced by Easter Joy. We follow Jesus, like the twelve, because we are drawn by him, drawn and attracted by the way this man Jesus lives, speaks, suffers, dies and rises. People left a lot to follow him, they left their dreams and their burdens, their families, and their businesses, and gave up their lives, drawn, attracted, challenged as we are now, by his words: Come, follow me.
