

Season of Lent

The season of Lent offers us as Christians an opportunity for reflection. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday.

we are asked to fast on that day as Jesus did in the desert. We also receive ashes as an out-

ward sign of our willingness to turn back to God. The Gospel tells us how to approach that renewal of our lives by prayer, fasting and almsgiving. 


