St. Patrick Patron of Ireland

It can be difficult to separate fact



from fiction in the life of St. Patrick, not unusual when he was probably born more than 1,600 years ago. His life is a wonderful example of

how God brings good out of evil. He tells us in his "confessions" how he was brought to Ireland to work as a slave at the age of 16, until that time he had little knowledge of God. In his loneliness and isolation he discovered the Lord, praying as many as 1000 prayers by day and the same by night as he tended the sheep on Sliabh Migh. Finally escaping, probably to France, he could not forget the needs of the pagans in Ireland. He was consecrated bishop at the age of forty three. In a dream it seemed that all the people of Ireland were calling on him to return.

During this time he converted many, ordained priests, divided the country into dioceses, held church councils, founded several monasteries for sisters and brothers, throughout the country. Patrick is the Patron Saint and credited with bringing Christianity to Ireland.

Christ shield me this day:

Christ with me, Christ before me, Christ behind me. Christ in me. Christ beneath me, Christ above me, Christ on my right, Christ on my left, Christ when I lie down, Christ when I arise, Christ in the heart of every person who thinks of me, Christ in the mouth of every person who speaks of me, Christ in the eye that sees me, Christ in the ear that hears me.
