Month of the Rosary

October along with being 'Mission Month' is also the Month Dedicated to the Rosary. In years past there was a wonderful Irish tradition of reciting the Rosary daily in our homes.

As the **Year of Faith** is drawing to a close it offers us once again an opportunity to begin reciting the Rosary.

October 7th is the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, also known as Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary. It was formerly known as the Feast of Our Lady of Victory and changed by Pope Gregory X111 in 1573.

In 1716 Pope Clement X1 inserted it into the Roman Catholic calendar of Saints, and assigned it to the first Sunday of October. Pope Pius X changed the date to October 7th in 1913, as part of his effort to restore celebration of the liturgy of the Sundays. On October 13th, 1917 *Our lady of Fatima* told the children, "I am the Lady of the Rosary"

We are all familiar with the *Joyful*, *Sorrowful* and *Glorious Mysteries* but, perhaps less so with the *Mysteries* of *Light*.

These were introduced by Pope John Paul and are as follows:

- 1. The Baptism of Jesus.
- 2. The Miracle of Cana.
- 3. The Proclamation of the Kingdom.
- 4. The Transfiguration of Our Lord.
- 5. The Institution of the Eucharist.
