



25th January – the octave of Saint Peter and Saint Paul. The theme this year is 'Is Christ Divided? This year's theme was chosen by the Churches of French Canada and comes from Saint Paul's provocative question in 1 Corinthians, "Has Christ been divided?". Paul begins his letters to the Corinthians with a powerful opening. This passage touches on themes that certainly prepare us for what is to come in these letters and lay a solid but challenging foundation for our reflections as Christians living and working together in churches and society today.

Reflections for each of the days begins with the word "Together" Together reminds us that in Christ we are one and that in all aspects of our Christian living we should seek to discover that unity which is God's gift to us. **Day 1: Together...**we are called to be saints (1 Cor 1: 2) Day 2: Together ... we give thanks for God's grace in one anoth*er (1 Cor 1: 4)*

Day 3: Together...we are not lacking in any spiritual gifts (1 Cor 1: 7) Day 4: Together ... we affirm that God is faithful (1 Cor 1: 9a) Day 5: Together...we are called into fellowship (1 Cor 1: 9b) Day 6: Together ... we seek to be in agreement (1 Cor 1:10) Day 7: Together ... we belong to Christ (1 Cor 1: 12-13) Day 8: Together...we proclaim the

gospel (1 Cor 1:17) We have journeyed through the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity reflecting on and celebrating how we are bound together as Christians.
