What is Ordinary Time in the Liturgical Calen-



dar? Besides the times of the year that have their own distinctive character, there remain in the yearly cycle thirty three or thirty four weeks in which no particular aspect of the mystery of Christ is celebrated, but rather the mystery of Christ itself is honoured in its fullness, especially on Sundays. This period is known as Ordinary Time. It begins on the Monday which follows the Sunday occuring after January 6th and extends up to and including the Tuesday before the beginning of Lent; it begins again on the Monday after Pentecost Sunday and ends before evening prayer of the First Sunday of Advent.
