

Shroud of Turin

A full-size copy of the world-famous Shroud of Turin, (long believed to be the burial cloth of the crucified Jesus), is coming to St Mary and St Anne's (North) Cathedral Cork.

It will be on display from March 20th to 30th, daily from 10.30am to 4.30pm. Admission Free



The Shroud of Turin Exhibition, a fifteen foot replica image which is a photograph printed onto cotton by an American photographer, Barrie Schwortz, who was the official photographer at the STURP (Shroud of Turin Research Project) examination of the Shroud in 1978.

The full-length replica is very rare and most people never get a chance to see a life sized copy of the Shroud.

The genuine Shroud of Turin is preserved with great reverence in the Cathedral of Turin.
