afterwards. If inclement weather conditions Mass will be celebrated indoors in the school. The signifance of beginning in the dark is that while we move from darkenss






to light, we mark the beginning of new life in Resurrection by beginning with lighting a new Paschal Candle to symbolise that Christ is the Light of the World All welcome


