

Mass of the Sick & Healing & Light

You are invited to the annual parish celebration of the Sacrament of the Sick/Healing/Light which will be held in the New School Hall in Ballygarvan on Monday May 19th at 7.30pm.

Everybody welcome to this Mass/

Sacrament. It is for all those who are sick physically, mentally or spiritually and in need of healing of any

and in need of healing of any kind. Light symbolises Hope in the future for us all.

The emphasis of the Sacrament of the Sick has changed dramatically since Vatican 2.
Up to that it was seen as the Sacra-

Up to that it was seen as the Sacrament of the dying, and was usually administered only on the death bed. People were reluctant to call the priest until the last moment in case it might alarm the sick person.

It was the Sacrament that prepared us for our final journey. Now it is seen as the *Sacrament of Healing*. Just as Christ healed the sick while he was on earth he continues to heal, in whatever way is necessary for each of us.

The Sacrament gives the grace of the Holy Spirit to those who are sick

The oil of the sick along with other oils is blessed by the Bishop at the Chrism Mass each Holy Thursday in the Cathedral of each Diocese.

The prayer used by the priest as each person is anointed with the oil of the sick on the forehead and on the palms of the hands is:



"Through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit." "May the Lord who frees you from sin, save you, and raise you up."

Amen.


