

Fr. Christy writes...

Mercy is the gift of God

Pope Francis speaking in 2013 said: "I am always struck when I reread the parable of the merciful Father. ... The Father, with patience, love,



hope and mercy, had never for a second stopped thinking about [his wayward son], and as soon as he sees him still far off, he runs out to meet him and embraces him with tenderness, the tenderness of God, without a word of reproach. ... God is always waiting for us. He never grows tired. Jesus shows

us this merciful patience of God so that we can regain confidence and hope — always!

Its a message that, when you think about it, is truly amazing. No matter what, God loves us, he is waiting for us to reach out to Him and he will always respond like the Father in the story of what we call the Prodigal Son. He heard the plea of Moses to show mercy. And he did. Such is

the power of his love, he showers us freely with his mercy. I think the whole point of this *Year of Mercy* is simply; as God is merciful to us, then, all he asks in return is that we too, are people who live a life that is merciful towards others.



"Let us commit ourselves to not put any obstacles to the Father's merciful acts," Pope Francis said. "Instead, let us ask for the gift of great faith to become signs and instruments of mercy."

The challenge for us is to identify how we can do that.


Farewell & Welcome
