

Fr. Christy writes...

TO BE MADE WHOLE AGAIN

What must it be like to lose everything; home, family, friends, neighbours and be an outcast? To be driven out because of fear of contamination, to be rejected to be an object of scorn and ridicule. The loneliness and isolation must be terrible let alone the shame.

That was par for the course in ancient times. No matter what it was, the

slightest blemish or rash and you were cast out as unclean. Naaman did the unthinkable, and washed himself in the river Jordan and he was made clean and became a believer.

Jesus, went a step further and risked all, he could have been cast out for having spoken to them. In other stories he touched them. For Jesus there were no barriers, only a way to bring people back, to include and restore them.



In November 2013, Pope Francis saw a man in the crowd who was severely disfigured by neurofibromatosis. This is a debilitating disease, which has devastating effects. The effects can include intense pain and suffering, vision problems, learning impediments, cancerous lesions and severe disfigurement. The physical effects can sometimes render those afflicted with such severe disfigurement that people recoil from even being around them. Pope Francis stopped and embraced the man, a modern day leper as some would call him.

For us, as this **Year of Mercy** draws to a close, what ways and in particular what parts of my life do I need to be restored, and made whole again? Where does my faith need to be strengthened? And, how can I reach out to include and bring others in from the outside?
