Fr. Christy writes

Go The Extra Mile

If only people took the gospel to heart we wouldn't have wars, violence, ethnic cleansing and racial and sectarian discrimination.

That's the reality, because Jesus in our Gospel this weekend is saying to turn the other cheek, to love our enemies, or to put it another way, to kill people with kindness.

That's a lot easier than it sounds, especially when the world tells us that all this is a sign of weakness. But Jesus has higher expectations of his followers. His way is a radical and non-violent way. Jesus is saying that by turning the other cheek we allow the potential for conversion in the other person, we allow the chance for the light of Christ to shine into those dark places of a person's heart.

As Jesus said, 'its easy to love those who love you.' The challenge for us is love our enemies, to turn the other cheek, to go the extra mile and give people the chance to see the power of the love of God made visible in Jesus Christ and reflected through us today. When you think about it, we each carry the Lord and his life giving Spirit within us, and so when we try to love, honour and respect God, we show that, by honouring and loving each other.

Being perfect as our Heavenly Father is perfect is a tall order and is very demanding, but when we try and we are people full of compassion, slow to anger, rich in mercy we are truly living lives of holiness, honesty and forgiveness just as Jesus himself did.
