JESUS WEPT!

It is the shortest verse in the entire bible "Jesus wept". He had come to his dear friends Martha and Mary and their brother Lazarus who had died by the time Jesus got there. I love the phrase 'with a sigh that came straight from his heart'. He felt their pain, he himself was overcome by loss and the great sigh from his heart led to his tears.
