Since it's formation over twenty years ago the **BCDA** has been responsible for the development, and on going management of the **Marian Hall**. This ensures that the people of **Ballinhassig Parish** can enjoy the use of the Hall for a wide variety of events such as **Meetings; Musical Events; Card Playing etc**. Rental Accommoda-

tion has also been provided for a *Montessori School* and a *Commercial Kitchen* at the rear of the Hall. *BCDA also have an agreement with Ballinhassig GAA providing them with a plot of land for their new development.*

BCDA has been servicing an **AIB Bank Loan** of which there is currently a balance owed of around **200K**. When one takes into account the monthly income from the Hall itself along with the rental income, generally it is quiet a challenge to meet the loan repayments.

In the early years *BCDA* had up to **eighteen committee members**. This enabled us to run some successful & notable fundraising events. Now as we approach 2018 and looking ahead we see more and more exciting events being planned by the numerous groups of our talented parishioners. The *Hall* which is the *Hub* of our community is now more in demand than ever and these events are so dependant on the use of it.

The organisation feels that this would be an opportune time for new thinking and are inviting new members to come on board and make

their contribution in shaping our much loved facility.
