#### THE GREAT WEEK

From the prophet Joel's call, on Ash Wednesday, 'Come back to me with all your heart' to St. Matthew reminding us of the three hallmarks of Lent. those being; prayer, fasting and almsgiving, we have arrived at the Great Week. That's what Holy Week was called. It's a celebration of what we call the Paschal Mystery, which means the Life, Death and Resurrection of Jesus. Holy Week

The prophet Joel and St. Matthew were trying to point us in the right direction from the start. Pointing us to what's important. Reminding us that it's all about this great Paschal Mystery, about the gift of God in Jesus and what it means for our lives.

This final week takes us from the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, at 8pm in Ballygravan, through the Liturgy of the Passion on Good Friday in Ballyheada at 3pm to the Easter Vigil. It's called the mother of all vigils because everything comes from it.

Our journey ends in the renewal of our Baptismal promises at that Easter Vigil, this year celebrated in Goggin's Hill, at 8.30pm and at our Dawn Mass outside the Marian Hall at 6am on Easter Sunday. Our journey to the renewal of these promises is for us a greater appreciation of the gift that has been given us in Jesus and recommitting ourselves to faith and living it out as Jesus asked us to.


#### **Chrism Mass**
