Annual Parish Accounts

This week-end in the final newsletter until September we see the publication of the **2017 Parish Accounts.** Our accountants have prepared accounts for submission to the diocese and were passed at a meeting of the **Parish Finance Committee** last Tuesday.

The *Parish Finance Committee* would like to take this opportunity to thank all our parishioners for their generous and unfailing support. In continuing challenging times for people, your generosity in not something we take for granted.

We take this opportunity to thank all who signed up for the *Tax Back Scheme* and those who support the parish through a *Direct Debit*. Both Tax Back Scheme and Direct Debit payments are vital methods of adding to the future income of the parish.

We note the following:-

*** The Offertory income shows a decrease of 5,000Euro on 2016

*** The 2017 tax back income (for those who signed up during 2017)

will not benefit us until 2018 as it won't be paid to us by Revenue until later this year. This figure will be reflected in the 2018 Parish Accounts.

There is also an additional Tax Back Payment of 4000Euro for 2017 which was only received in 2018 and will be reflected in the 2018 Parish Accounts .

- *** Those who sign up for the Tax Back Scheme are assured that information is treated in the strictest confidence.
- *** You are invited to participate in The Tax Back Scheme by contacting Mary in the PAN Centre/Parish Office **4885062**.
- ***The Parish Finance Committee are hopeful of a successful conclusion to the sale of the right hand side of the old school site in Ballygarvan.
- *** The amount outstanding on the Loan as at 31/12/17 is 251,279Euro

What the tax back scheme means

If a person signs up for this scheme it means, that once they pay 250Euro or over in the year, *the parish can claim back the tax* they have paid on that amount, at no extra cost to the person. People on this scheme use the box of weekly parish envelopes and let us know their box number or they can sign up to pay by direct debit or use any of the payment methods listed overleaf.
