



THE LORD SPEAKS THROUGH US!

A prophet is never accepted in his own country. Jeremiah was most reluctant. He knew what he was being called to. The prophet's job often made him unpopular as he had to frequently challenge the people by telling them a few home truths, and they didn't like it.

Jesus, the local boy, also faced similar challenges. In one breath they were astounded by the wisdom that came from his lips, but the statement 'This is Joseph's son, surely', they are not just saying who he is, it's a put down and they are rejecting him and what he has to say. They turned on Jesus pretty quickly when they didn't like what they were hearing.

In our own time and in the world of today, sometimes it is not easy being a person of faith. What we have to say might be unpopular. The challenge to what we believe and hold dear can be so strong. We, like Jeremiah and Jesus are invited not to be afraid and to trust.
