Our New Bishop

The news came quickly in the end. Bishop Buckley had submitted his letter of resignation on reaching 75, to Pope Francis, in November 2014. Last Sunday at teatime we received an email inviting us to Mass at 10.15am in the Cathedral the following morning, where the Papal Nuncio would make the announcement.

We were introduced to Fr. Fintan Gavin, from Dublin. He was to be our new Bishop. His ordination date will be announced shortly. He told us he was a northsider, from Marino and is one of seven children. Both his parents are still living. He was ordanized 27 years ago and is 53.

He has served in a number of parishes, greatly involved with ministry to young people, and is known for his involvement with the Gospel Choir from Our Lady of Victories Parish. He is a trained canon lawyer and most recently served as chancellor of the archdiocese of Dublin, which is a major administrative role. We look forward to his ministry as Bishop amongst us and pray that God may fill him with his spirit of enthusiasm, health and energy as he assumes his new role and the many challenges that he faces.

We take this time too, to honour and pay respect to the enormous commitment and service Bishop Buckley has given to the diocese as he looks forward to his retirement. Bishop Buckley was ordained a priest in 1965, this year celebrating 54 years. He was ordained Auxiliary Bishop of Cork and Ross in 1984. On Friday 19th December, 1997, the Holy See announced the appointment of Bishop John Buckley as Bishop of Cork and Ross. Bishop Buckley was the Diocesan Administrator since the death of Bishop Michael Murphy in October 1996, and was installed as Bishop of the diocese on February 8th, 1998. We pray he will continue to be blessed with good health and enjoy his well earned retirement for many years to come.



Chrism Mass


On Holy Thursday morning **April 18th** the priests of the diocese will renew their commitment to priesthood and invite the people to pray for
