

Fr. Christy writes

JESUS TRANSFORMS US

After the second appearance of the Risen Lord to the apostles, they certainly believed Jesus was alive and had been raised from the dead. They still didn't quite know what to do though, so they went fishing, back to what they did know.

We do much the same thing in our daily lives. Our faith in Jesus does not always seem to energise us because it is not often truly at the center of our lives. It is there, perhaps quietly.

Then Jesus comes along as only he can! He gives the apostles a different direction to go, takes care of them by feeding them spiritually and physically, asks for a reaffirmation of faith, and then offers them an invitation. So, too, with us!

Jesus is always present to us, sometimes in what seems almost physical ways and sometimes in the quiet of our hearts. Jesus steers us away from what might even be good but not just what he wants us to do more enthusiastically in his name. He nourishes us in the Eucharist, through our private prayer with him, and through the people we have in our lives.

This Easter Season is the time for us to reaffirm our faith by realising we might not have been faithful to what Jesus asked of us. Once again, it is time to rejoice in the unconditional love of the Risen Lord! It is time to listen to the Spirit's invitation to new life within us.

Let us put Jesus firmly in the center of our lives through prayer so we may "follow" him more authentically in our own journey. Let us intentionally infuse kindness into everything we do. Let us rediscover the joy and consolation of being a Christian this Easter Season!
