Finance Committee writes.....

Annual Parish Accounts

This week-end in the final newsletter until September we see the publication of the 2018 Parish Accounts. Our accountants have prepared accounts for submission to the diocese and were passed at a meeting of the Parish Finance Committee last Tuesday. The 2018 Financial Accounts for the Parish show a substantial loss for the year. Despite tight control on expenditure with minor expenses on church maintenance/repairs only the most essential works are now being carried out. It is clearly evident that income from weekly contributions have dropped by another 2260Euro in 2018.

The decline in church income from weekly contribution is not just confined to our parish, this is now the case with many parishes throughout the diocese and the country for that matter. However of immediate concern to us here in this parish is our own financial position. If the present trend continues then it is only a matter of time before we are confronted with the situation of not being able to make ends meet.

Falling numbers attending our churches for week-end Masses is of course a factor and we have to accept that fact. However, on a very positive note there is no decline in the number of our parishioners attending our churches for many other services and events throughout the year, in particular our First Holy Communions, Confirmations, Weddings, Christmas and Easter and indeed there are other occasions where for one reason or another we assemble in great numbers in each of our three churches.

Our three church buildings are very important to all of us here in the parish of Ballinhassig and especially to the parishioners of Goggins Hill, Ballygarvan and Ballyheada church areas. It is important that the churches should be maintained to the standards that have existed for the past 200 years and when we attend there we find that they are well kept and up to present day standards.

We are extremely grateful to our parishioners who are making their regular contributions. We thank all of you and again we would very much appreciate that those of you *contributing in excess of 250Euro annually would sign up to avail of the Tax Back Scheme* (if you haven't already done so) This is now a major source of income and in **2019 should be in excess of 12,000Euro, but** this will barely help us meet our monthly repayments on the **Loan** which now stands at **236,000Euro**.

We also accept that some of our parishioners attend week-end Masses at other churches and contribute there. To those that attend both in our parish churches and outside we ask you to be more generous at home than away.

As a *Finance Committee* it is unreasonable to expect those that are contributing generously either annually, by direct debit or by the weekly contributions to be solely responsible for Parish Income. An increasing number of our parishioners now attend our churches more as special occasions or otherwise on a less frequent basis therefore do not have the opportunity to contribute to the financial support of our parish on an on going basis. It is important to keep in mind that the parish in general provides an excellent service to all our parishioners including the service provided by the Parish Centre and our Secretary.

We are now appealing to all those who may not have had the opportunity to making a financial contribution in the past to now seriously consider doing so. Every contribution is now of extreme importance to us and a little donation with the price of a weekly cup of coffee will help enormously in ensuring that we will be in a position to finance the day to day running of the parish at least for the foreseeable future. Any suitable arrangement to facilitate contributing can be made with the Parish Secretary. On a final note incurring any further borrowings is not an option.
