Finance Committee writes......

ANNUAL PARISH ACCOUNTS FOR 2019

THIS, the final newsletter until September, contains the publication of the Parish Accounts for 2019. The accounts show a major reduction in our operating deficit. Again, this is due to the tremendous generosity of the people of Ballinhassig Parish. The numbers signed up to the Revenue Tax Back Scheme continues to increase as does the numbers of parishioners who have signed up for Standing Orders and Direct Debits. Expenditure has been reduced and Offertory collections have increased by $\ensuremath{\in} 3210$, with overall income up by almost $\ensuremath{\in} 10,000$ mainly due to fundraising.

Our priority continues to be the stabilising of our finances and the reduction of the parish debt as soon as is possible to enable the parish to move forward. The annual cost of servicing the loan is in the order of £21,000.

Ballinhassig Parish Finance & Buildings Committee sincerely thank all those who continue to support our parish so generously and so consistently, given the demands on people to-day.

We thank and acknowledge also those who have made donations/bequests. It's amazing how all these contributions, no matter how small, add up.
