



Parish Finance Committee writes...

FINANCIAL UPDATE

This has been a most difficult year for everyone with the Coronoavirus. Yet, the people of this parish have been tremendous in their generosity in their continued financial support for our parish.

Since the lockdown in March people have contributed €27,343 in the envelopes for the Offertory collections. This is truly amazing given the fact we were shut down for four and a half months. In the same time period last year people contributed €40,632. Increasing numbers now also pay by monthly Standing Order or Direct Debit. While at the same time, contributions from parishioners and fundraising events amounted to €4490.00, this was also used to reduce the parish debt. We will in due course acknowledge those contributions. A special word of thanks to the Ballinhassig Camogie Club and Ballinhassig Parish Assembly.

We have news also on the final sale of the vacant school site in Ballygarvan. The site sold for €124,000 but with substantial costs and expenses for Legal Fees, Auctioneers Fees and Diocesan 5% levy amounting to €17,572, the final amount we received was €106,428. We paid €97,500 of this off against the Parish Debt and the remaining €8928 was lodged to the parish current account. This time last year the Parish Debt stood at €226,000 but now the Parish Debt is reduced to €99,950.

We would like to take this opportunity to express our thanks to the parishioners and the Community Association in Ballygarvan, for their help and co-operation in the successful completion of the sale of the site.

The people of the parish have consistently worked hard and contributed generously over the years to reduce our debt and now we can truly say there is light and the end of the tunnel. Working together, as we have done, into the future, we will finally eliminate this debt. (Parish Finance Committee:- Patsy Galvin, chairperson; John McCann, secretary; Eileen Donohoe, treasurer; Fr. Shoe Box Appeal 2020

This year Team Hope *Shoe Box Appeal* will be run very differently. Due to Covid-19 restrictions we will be unable to fill our shoe boxes and have them delivered in the usual way. So in 2020 it is not possible to physically send gift filled shoe boxes from Ireland, *but you have the opportunity to donate gift filled boxes on line.*

The year may be different but the need for children to receive their shoe box is more important than ever.

Log in to Team Hope and you can create your shoe box any time up to December 23rd but preferably from November 9th to 15th. Follow the steps to fill your box or go directly to donate. If you create your own box add a mixture of the 4w's, WASH, WRITE, WEAR and WOW. This means a child will get items they need and love. Each box will cost 20Euro or donate what you can.

These donations will allow the local networks in Eastern Europe & Africa to purchase items for shoeboxes, which will then be delivered straight into the hands of children affected by poverty in orphanages and the wider community.

(Last year a total of 794 Shoe Boxes were donated by Ballinhassig Parish)
