Preparations are now in full swing, even with the restrictions for Level 3, for Christmas. Many things will be possible, many will still be able to meet and celebrate with family. Others may find that they are unable to travel home. It's certainly going to be a different Christmas in many respects for all of us. The Birthday of the Lord, his coming amongst us, born in humble circumstances, is worthy of celebration, no matter what, and we still need to prepare.

In our churches too, it will be different. We will be able over the course of Christmas to welcome 1250 people during the 25 Masses being celebrated, beginning at 4.00pm on Christmas Eve and concluding with 11.00am in Ballygarvan on 6th January. We would love to be able to accommodate everyone, but with the restrictions, 50 people (includes) children is the maximum number we can have at any Mass, in any of our churches. Our practice has been, since we reopened for public Masses at the end of June, to place a sign outside the door of the church, 'church full' once 50 people are inside. We will continue this practice and will not operate a ticketing or booking system for places at the Christmas Masses.

We are, in Ballinhassig Parish, encouraging people to take the opportunity to reflect and decide which one of the 25 Masses, they will attend for Christmas this year, remembering too, that the Sunday obligation remains suspended. In this way we will be able to welcome and celebrate with 1250 people over the entire Christmas period. We invite you then to pick a Mass on a particular day over the 12 days, and let this be your Christmas Mass.

Our churches will be open and visits to the Crib will be possible each day from 9.30am-400pm, to say a prayer and light your candles.


Advent is a time for us to **prepare** to receive Jesus into our **hearts**, our **lives**, our **homes** and our **parish**.


We need to **invite** him.
