## **CELEBRATING MASS TOGETHER AGAIN**

Thank God! We can return to the public celebration of Mass together for the first time since Christmas Day. We can do so again thanks to the commitment of a great team of volunteers as stewards who along with the Parish Assembly and the Parish Covid Committee, working together, to ensure we can gather in a safe way according to HSE and Government guidelines. We begin next weekend May 15th/16th.

It has been a difficult time and many sacrifices have been made by everyone. Now, with our return to public Masses, we have to implement certain procedures to help keep us all safe. These procedures, we know, can be frustrating, but we need to continue to be careful and take care of each other, which is why we are asked to wear a mask, **vaccinated or not**.

# We might not be able to sit in the seat we have always sat in, because of seats being closed off and having to maintain 2 metre physical distancing, this will be a challenge for many people, which we totally respect.

Also, because of adhering to the guidelines, Holy Communion may only be received in the hand for the foreseeable future.

Because our churches will be limited in the numbers we can have and to help and support people stewards will be there to help, advise and give directions. Seating will be from the top of the church. Once 50 people have entered, a sign will be placed outside to indicate we have reached our capacity. Because we cannot operate a one way system for Holy Communion in Ballygarvan, Holy Communion will be distributed to people in their seats with the priest and minister wearing a facemask, using the empty seat in front of you. In Ballyheada and Goggins Hill we will operate a one way system.

We are all in this together and we also need to individually accept responsibility to ensure we all follow the advice to keep each other safe. So please, co-operate with the stewards at all times. They are there for your safety as well as everyone else. People are encouraged, to avail of the 3 weekdays as well as of Sunday to ensure we can maximise our numbers.

SUNDAY OBLIGATION IS NOT RESTORED.

#### We will return to Public Masses from Saturday next May 15th.

Please arrive a little earlier to facilitate the implementation of all safety procedures. Because we have to use a one way system **ENTRY THROUGH MAIN DOORS ONLY.** Exit will be through the Side Doors only in all churches.

When waiting to enter & exit we need to continue to be mindful of the <u>2 metre physical</u> <u>distancing</u>.

If you have been wearing gloves coming into the church they must be removed, and disposable ones placed in the bin before sanitising your hands

Holy Water Fonts will have to remain empty until the advice on this changes.

Handshake for the Sign of Peace is suspended

#### No entry to the Sacristy before Mass.

No lighting of candles before Mass. It will, be possible afterwards. No Stations of the Cross before Mass. It will, be possible afterwards.

Baptisms will be celebrated on Saturdays only at 12 noon & 5 pm.

When you enter the church **STEWARDS** will

Invite you to sanitise your hands.

Guide you towards an available seat as seating will begin from the top of the church. People living in the same household may share a pew.

In Ballyheada & Goggins Hill guide you in rotation to Holy Communion using a one way system.

Guide you in rotation for exiting the church and inviting you to sanitise your hands before leaving.

For the safety and wellbeing of everyone, Parishioners are asked not to congregate in groups outside the church doors.



As we cannot have the traditional offertory collection by passing baskets around, baskets will be provided at the main door each day to facilitate people to leave their offering on any day of the week.

Unfortunately, *Fr. Christy & Rev. John* will not be able to greet people at the door at the end of Mass.

**Choirs** aren't possible for the foreseeable future, due to current health advice. **Altar Servers aren't permitted for the time being also.** 

Adhering to HSE and Government Guidelines at the moment we are limited in our capacity.
