A MESSAGE FROM THE PARISH FINANCE COMMITTEE

On the 31st December, 2021 our parish debt was €68,000, this is significantly down from €226,000 in August 2019. For many years now, this has been a major drain on Parish Finances and this reduction is certainly most welcome. Our target now is to have the parish loan/debt repaid in 2 years.

The reduced debt was achieved through the continued generous support of our parishioners, along with the proceeds from the sale of the site in Ballygarvan €97,000; our monthly bank repayments of €1812 & the individual contributions of parishioners.

We have all been through difficult times for the past two years. Parishes generally have suffered financially through lockdowns and restrictions. The people of this parish have been extremely generous always but especially during that period, in not only ensuring that the Parish and Priests income is close to pre-pandemic level, but also in making a substantial contribution towards the reduction of the Parish Debt. The Parish Finance Committee along with Fr. Christy wish to acknowledge your generosity and we look forward to your continued financial support for 2022.

The Tax Refund Scheme is now a very important source of income and we ask those who are contributing €250 or more over the course of the year and haven't as yet signed the special form, to consider doing so. Hopefully 2022 will see a return to unrestricted numbers for all Church sevices. When we are in a position to return to normality, you will find that when you do so, either to celebrate with relations/friends or on difficult family occasions, you will find our churches welcoming and well maintained as you would like them to be.


