



200 YEARS OF WORSHIP

1822 was still 7 years away from Catholic Emancipation, and yet the second of the three churches in Ballinhassig Parish was built. Times were hard, catholics were only beginning to celebrate Mass and the sacraments publicly, but were slightly fearful as it was still strictly illegal.

Yet, Ballygarvan church is a testament to the faith of the people 200 years ago and the many sacrifices they had endured for their faith. It did not deter them however when it came to building churches to the glory of God, no matter the cost. They built their churches in prominent places, to be seen and to call people together to worship and prayer. To say we owe them an enormous debt of gratitude would be an understatement.

Celebrating the bicentenary of Ballygarvan church this weekend, we welcome Bishop Fintan. We thank the many people who have been involved in preparing the church for this weekend's celebrations and also those who will take part in the bicentenary Mass.

The legacy that our forebears have left is immeasurable and the responsibility handed on to us is no less. Many generations have taken this up and helped to preserve that legacy of faith. For it to endure, we all need to continue to play our part, to preserve the built heritage we have and to carry on the rich legacy of faith and worship we have inherited.
