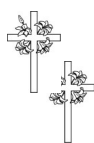

Left over palms will be kept until next year, burned, and the ashes will be used for distribution on Ash Wednesday



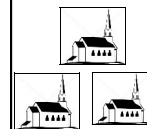

The readings for the fifth Sunday of Lent are about how God can take us from death to new life. The first reading tells us of God's desire to bring us back to life. The second reading tells us if Christ dwells in us, we will have new life as he does. And the Gospel tells us how Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead.

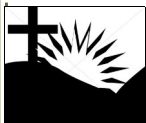
