# **Expressing Our Gratitude and Thanks**

The Financial Report for 2023 will be the final Report of the present Finance Committee already on an extended term. It is now an appropriate opportunity to update our Parishioners on the present financial position, also to express our deep gratitude and thanks to all who helped us to reach it.



#### In August 2019 our Parish Debt was 226,000Euro.

A target date of *August 31st 2024* was set to have this debt cleared, while this might have appeared optimistic at the time, we can now state with confidence that the debt which now stands at 12,000E (when we transfer 10,000 from the current account) will be eliminated by February 2024 (4 1/2 years) Considering that this was done during Covid years when all parishes suffered serious loss of income was a tremendous achievement by the people of the Parish.

We celebrated the *Bicentenaries of our three churches 2021, 2022 and 2023.* All churches were externally power washed and painted, trees cut and removed in *Ballygarvan and Ballyheada*. Works carried out at *Ballyheada* church grounds and graveyard included re-standing old headstones, re-erecting Mass Path Cross, removal of overgrowth and planting of flowers. In addition *Church Bells* at *Ballygarvan and Ballyheada* were restored. (*Goggins Hill planned for 2024*). The Parish was not in a position to finance these works independently. Through the excellent spirit of volunteerism, private donations and contributions in other ways we were able to get the works done at minimum costs to the Parish.

Our Parish has had to deal with a serious burden of debt for a long number of years and to reach our current position is most certainly welcome.

We would like to express our appreciation to the following:-

All previous Finance Committees for their hard work.



2. Various Parish & Community Groups for their fundraising ventures down through the years.

3. Each and everyone that gave of their time and talents in helping the Parish. Professional people in many different aspects, skilled and unskilled workers, those who continuously maintain all our graveyards and ladies and gents who ensured our churches were always clean and welcoming.

4. The various community groups in Ballygarvan and particularly the Community Association for their co-operation in the successful sale of the Old School Site in 2020 for 106,000Euro which reduced our debt considerably.

5. To all our former Parish Priests, Curates and our ex Deacon John Guirey for their work, help and assistance.

6. Finally thanks to all Parishioners who by your weekly contributions and those who made individual contributions in any way down through the years have helped us reach our target to eliminate the debt.

The Final Fund Raising event of this Committee will be in Ballygarvan Church in Spring 2024 when due to popular demand the Celtic Tenors will be returning for the second year in a row. Tickets will be available shortly and can be pre booked as numbers will be limited to 250. (Parish Office 021/4885062)
