Lenten Season of Reflection

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, we are asked to fast on that day as Jesus did in the desert. We also receive ashes as an outward sign of our willingness to turn back to God. The Gospel tells us how to approach that renewal of our lives by prayer, fasting and almsgiving. We are encouraged to stop, to take a look at our lives, to see where we are going. It is at this time of the year that we are encouraged to step out of our usual patterns of life and become more aware of our relationship with ourselves, with others and with our God. Lent is a time for *Prayer*, *Fasting and Almsgiving*.

Purple vestments are worn by the priest during Lent.

.. The Gloria and Alleluia are not prayed during Lent.

.. Decoration of the *sanctuary and altar* are *simple* during Lent.

.. Lent is a time to give up or take up in preparation for Easter.

Ordinary Time

What is Ordinary Time in the **Liturgical Calendar?** Besides the times of the year that have their own distinctive character. there remain in the yearly cycle thirty three or thirty four weeks in which no particular aspect of the mystery of Christ is celebrated, but rather the mystery of Christ itself is honoured in its fullness, especially on Sundays.

This period is known as *Ordinary* **Time**. It begins on the *Monday* which follows the Sunday occuring after January 6th and extends up to and including the Tuesday before the beginning of Lent; it begins again on the Monday after Pentecost Sunday and ends before evening prayer of the First Sunday of Advent.
