



Symbols of Lent in our Homes

We need to choose to let our homes be a place full of the Holy things that help raise our minds and hearts to God. As we journey through Lent perhaps we could begin to make ourselves more aware of the significance of the following symbols in our home.



Water:- We can pray over a simple bowl of holy water, in a central place. "Lord, may this water remind us of our baptism and be a blessing for our home, where our dying and rising in you is lived each day. Bless us, as we sign ourselves with it each day."

Sand:- A bowl of sand can help us remember our journey. God led the people in their journey in the desert. Jesus re-enacted that journey to face his own temptations. The desert can be a place of retreat where there is freedom from distractions.

Candle:- Place a candle in a central place in your home and begin praying over it as we begin Lent. "Lord thank you for the gift of your Light in the midst of all darkness. Let this candle be a symbol of our faith in your presence among us." This will prepare us for the lighting of the New Fire at the Easter Vigil. Baptismal candles belong to our children, could also be lit,

we can remember the words "*Receive the light of Christ... Keep this flame burning brightly.*"



Bible:- The prominent presence of a *Bible* in our home can represent for us our desire for God's Word in our lives. Eventhough the story is the same we continuously find new meaning.


In this season of Lent we need to turn our attention to our inner preparation for Easter.


Trócaire - Lent
