Mary O'H writes....

Holy Week begins this Sunday

Holy Week is a special week for all of us and begins on Passion (Palm Sunday). The remembering of the story of the



Passion has touched hearts down through the centuries. Sunday Why are we so touched by recalling the events of the first Holy Week? Maybe

because in the story of Jesus's Passion. we find our own life story.

First, there's the Mass of Chrism on Holy Thursday morning, when priests renew their solemn promises.

The Mass of the Lord's Supper that evening is like being at the Last Supper itself. We re-enact the washing of the feet. a reminder of Jesus' command to love one another

The Mass begins in triumph, but ends in heartbreak, with the mournful procession to the Altar of Repose, from the Upper Room to Gethsemane.

Good Friday a day for fasting and prayer. It is the most solemn of all

days. We listen to the story of the Passion and death of Jesus and are invited to venerate the cross

Holy Saturday - a day of death, of waiting, Easter has not come. Easter Vigil is the most important celebration of the year. Miss that, and you've missed it all. The forty days of Lent are to prepare for that Baptismal celebration

At the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night we remember and re-tell our story from beginning to end. We keep vigil and move from darkness to light; we mark the beginning of new life in resurrection by lighting a new Paschal Candle and blessing fresh baptismal water. The pain of Holv Week is replaced by *Easter Jov*. We follow Jesus, like the twelve, because we are drawn by him, attracted by the way this man Jesus lives, speaks, suffers, dies and rises. People followed him,

they left their dreams. their families, their businesses, and gave up their lives, and were attracted and challenged as we are now, by his words: Come, follow me.



Chrism Mass

Mass of Chrism on Holy Thursday April 17th at 10.00am, at Holy the Cathedral of St. Mary and St. Anne.

(the North Cathedral)

This is the only Mass celebrated in the diocese on this morning.

At this Mass with priests & parishioners

from the Diocese the Oils of Baptism and the Sick are blessed. Bishop Fintan will



consecrate the Oil of Chrism. The *Holv Oils* blessed at this Mass are brought back to the parishes by the priests for use during the coming year in the celebration of the sacraments in the parish. *These oils are Chrism: the* Oil of Catechumens and the Oil of the Sick. The Holv Chrism is used in baptism. confirmation, to bring support and comfort to the sick in Holy Thursday

their infirmity, to anoint the hands of priests and the heads of bishops at ordination.

The priests of the diocese will renew their commitment to priesthood during the Mass. All welcome.
