St. Faustina - Divine Mercy

Saint Faustina was born Helena Kowalska in a village west of Lodz, Poland on August 25, 1905. She was the third of ten children. When she was twenty, she entered the *Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy*, whose members devote themselves to the care and education of troubled young women. The following year she received her religious habit and was given the name *Sister* Maria Faustina, to which she added, "of the Most Blessed Sacrament" as was permitted by her congregation's custom. In the 1930's, *Sister Fausting* received from the Lord a message of mercy that she was told to spread throughout the world. She was asked to become the apostle of God's mercy, a model of how to be merciful to others. Her entire life, was to be a sacrifice,

a life lived for others. At the Divine Lord's request, she willingly offered personal sufferings in union with Him to atone for the sins of others; in her daily life she was a doer of mercy, bringing joy and peace to others, and by writing about God's mercy, she was to encourage others to trust in Him and prepare the world for His coming again.



Her special devotion to Mary Immaculate and the sacraments of Eucharist and Reconciliation gave her the strength to bear all her sufferings as an offering to God on behalf of the Church and those in special need, especially sinners and the dying. She wrote and suffered in secret, with only her spiritual director and some of her superiors aware that anything special was taking place in her life. After her death



from tuberculosis in 1938, even her closest associates were amazed as they began to discover what great sufferings and deep mystical experiences had been given to this Sister of theirs, who had always been so cheerful and humble. The message of mercy that Sister Faustina received is now spread throughout the world; her diary, **Divine Mercy** in my Soul, has become the handbook for devotion to the Divine Mercy.

Divine Mercy Novena

Christ asked Saint Faustina to recite The Divine Mercy Novena starting on Good Friday and ending on Divine Mercy Sunday. Adoration, Roary, Chaplet, Benediction, Mass in Church of Real Presence Curraheen this Sunday April 27th, beginning at 2.00pm, and Mass at 3.30pm.

Pope Francis

The world was saddened to learn of the death of Pope Francis on April 21st. We give thanks to God for the life of Pope Francis who was a

true shepherd of his global flock. His dedication and selfless service to all throughout the world especially the poor and migrants and those on the margins, be it physically, emotionally or spiritually. Despite ill health and frailty his final address to the world was on Easter Day of the Lord's Resurrection and an apt time for him to be called Home to the Lord. May He Rest In Peace.
